This 1 day course is designed for persons who conduct or oversee non-abatement Lead-Based Paint (LBP) activities. This course is required by HUD for persons conducting non-abatement LBP activity as part of a federally funded project. This course also satisfies the training requirement to obtain Wisconsin Department of Health Services Renovator Certification for individuals and companies that is required under the new Wisconsin Lead Rules.

This course is designed to educate attendees how to conduct renovating and remodeling activities in a lead-safe manner. Topics covered include background information on lead, health effects of exposure to lead, regulations, worksite preparation, conducting interim control and non-abatement activities, work site clean-up and disposal. This class satisfies the training requirement to become State of Wisconsin and EPA certified as a Lead Safe Renovator. **On and after April 22 of 2010, each crew conducting remodeling, renovating and/or painting activities in homes built before 1978 will have to have at least one member that has completed this training and is certified as a Lead Safe Renovator.** Even in the case of a single person performing the remodeling, renovating and/or painting activities, that individual would have to have the training and certification to comply to the new standard.
